Safeguarding and Promoting Children's Welfare



Safeguarding is everyone's responsibility

In the event of a disclosure / incident:

Do

- Stay calm
- Take what child says seriously and accept it
- Allow child to continue at own pace
- Let them know you will need to tell someone
- Reassure child they have done the right thing
- Let child know what is going to happen next
- Report conversation to designated person.

Don't

- Promise confidentiality
- Ask leading questions
- Confront the alleged abuser
- Ask child to repeat what has been said
- Interview other children or parents



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What is Child Protection?

- Child Protection refers to the activities which are undertaken to protect specific children who are suffering or at risk of suffering significant harm.

What is safeguarding?

It also includes:

- Pupil health and safety
- Anti-Bullying and cyber-bullying
- Meeting the needs of pupils with medical conditions.
- Providing first aid
- Educational visits
- Intimate care
- Internet safety

Protecting children from maltreatment / abuse

Preventing impairment of children's health or development / neglect

Safeguarding is not just about protecting children from deliberate harm.
