IMPORTANT INFORMATION as your child returns to school

Will my child need to wear school uniform?

It is more important that clothing is clean on each day and we will not require pupils to wear school uniform for the remainder of term.

What equipment will my child need?

It is advised as little is brought to school as possible to stop cross-contamination between school and home.

Pupils will not be sharing pens and pencils - every pupil will be given equipment that will be solely for their use.

Ideally, pupils should bring in no more than a lunch box and water bottle.

When will the school day begin?

Key Worker parents will be asked to indicate arrival and pick-up times when booking weekly provision. Other pupils have been given a staggered arrival time between 8.15am and 8.45am – arriving in 15 minute slots.

Pupils should be accompanied by no more than one adult.

In line with the Government restrictions, please do not allow your child to walk to school with other pupils who do not live with you.

Pupils will need to arrive in their allocated arrival time, a maximum of 5 minutes early.

Late arrivals must NOT enter the building; pupils will need to ring the bell and they will be collected.

Will my child have a break?

All pupils will have two socially-distanced breaks each day. Where possible these will take place outside - if the weather is poor, breaks will take place in the classroom.

Lunchtime

Lunchtime will be challenging so we are eating meals in the classrooms.

School Dinners (from a restricted menu) will only be available for children of Key Worker parents.

Payment must be made via ParentPay; no cash payments can be accepted.

All other pupils must bring their own packed lunch, including those eligible for free school meals.

Pupils are not to share their food or drinks.

All pupils will have a 30 minute, socially-distanced break after lunch each day, outside if the weather permits.

What will happen at the end of the school day?

Pupils will not be bringing reading books or other work home.

At the end of the day pupils must leave the school site when dismissed. They may not wait for other groups to be dismissed.

Pupils have been given a staggered dismissal time between 3.00pm and 3.30pm – leaving in 15 minute slots.

We would advise that public transport is not used.

Will I be able to come into school?

Parents will not be able to come into the building.

Any meetings will take place over the phone.

Parents must observe strict social distancing when dropping children off at school.

We would advise that parents do not gather outside school at the end of the day as this adds complexity to our ability to social distance.

Health and Safety

Parents/Carers will be asked to complete a daily Screening Questionnaire in relation to their child(ren) and household.

Each child's temperature will be checked on arrival at school.

Social distancing will be expected for your child and your family's safety and the safety of all staff and pupils in the school.

Anybody failing to socially distance will be asked to work from home.

First Aid will only be administered for accidents on site and will be kept to a necessary minimum.

Water fountains will be turned off – pupils need to bring a drink with them.

Children cannot attend school if they are unwell.

Important Dates

We will start to reopen for pupils from Monday 29th June 2020 with the purpose being to **check-in, catch up and prepare** with pupils for next term.

Our weekday wrap-around provision for Key Worker pupils continues. Any other pupil will have the opportunity to attend school up to four times before the end of term.

The last day of term is Friday 24th July 2020.

Where will my child go?

Key Worker pupils will be together in a Bubble Group in the Hall on the day(s) they attend.

All other pupils have been allocated to a Class Bubble Group and they will remain in this group for the day.

Class Bubble Groups will be allocated to a single classroom and all their teaching will happen in that classroom.

All rooms have been cleaned and arranged to support social distancing. All have hand sanitizer dispensers.

All rooms will be thoroughly cleaned at the end of every day after the pupils leave.

Who will teach my child?

Class Bubble pupils will be with their usual teacher. Key Worker Bubble pupils will be with other staff. All school staff will observe social distancing. Online learning will continue for all pupils until the end of term.

Please be aware, school will look and feel very different. Once preparations are complete, we hope to share a 'walk-through' video with pupils and parents.

We will be in touch with more information about what September 2020 will look like before the end of term.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank all of our parents and carers for all your support during what has been, and continues to be, a challenging time.

Although things will be different to what we are used to, we are really looking forward to seeing the pupils again – we have missed them. We want to reassure you that the safety of pupils, families and staff is at the forefront of all that we are doing.
